Photograph:

One of the most unsung heroes of Bletchley Park during WWII was Hugh Alexander. In 1941, Hugh worked in Hut 8 and became Alan Turing's deputy. One of Hugh's strengths was his administrative ability. He rearranged the personnel structure of Hut 8, allowing Alan Turing more time to work on his highly complex U-boat 4-rotor Enigma problems and not be bothered by less important office duties. Hugh was also a British chess champion.
