

Hello, Enigma World Code Group friends,

It is time for September's Enigma history message and challenge message. Our history message this month is broken into 3 parts, so that it won't seem so overwhelming. If you would like, just do one part at a time, and then take a little break. Notice that the header has been changed to show that there are 3 parts to the message, and each part is also numbered. Remember, don't try to decrypt the first 5 letters. They are the Kenngruppen. Just verify that one of the Kenngruppen trigrams for our date matches the trigram in the message, with 2 random letters added. Let's use my U571 codesheet for February 20, 1944, on this first section, and we will use the Model B machine again.
