

**Enigma Newsletter for April, 2015:**

On 4 March 1941, one of Winston Churchill's beloved Norwegian commando raids took place in Vestfjord port, off the Lofoten Islands. As far as anyone knew, it was another of those morale-boosting attacks by stretched-thin British forces that would blow-up fuel tanks and fish factories, sink a small German trawler or two caught in the port, and withdraw before the Germans could react. But this raid, Operation Claymore, had a top secret component to it. It was suspected that the trawlers in these waters had Enigma machines and documents on board. If one of these trawlers could be captured or boarded during the raid, perhaps the key to the German Naval 4-rotor Enigma could be found.
