Here is our Newsletter for June: Yank Shows Grit for Enigma. This is one of my favorite Enigma stories to come out of World War II. Did you know that the United States had a rather large contingent of troops working in and around Bletchley Park during the war? It's true. As early as 1940, GI's were there. As the war progressed, more than 500 Yanks would end-up working with our British cousins to help break Enigma.

Let's use my U-571 code sheet for June (Juni) 28, 1944

"ISYBC" is the Kenngruppen. Is it valid for June 28, 1944? Start decrypting with "SQO....."
